WhatsApp Concerns

We have had recent reports of unkind messaging and behaviours on WhatsApp between our children. It is advisable that you aim to have as open relationship as possible with your children regarding their conversations on social media. Open and honest conversation will support your children to come to you (or indeed adults at school) if they do encounter a worry or find themselves in a situation they may present to them as a dilemma. We know many Bosmere children are part of a number of WhatsApp groups and increasingly see how flippant some can be in their typing and sending of unkind remarks, possibly at times, more so than if they were face to face with the individuals. Please do have a chat with your children-we are always here to help and support if required, so get in touch if you would like to seek advice or support.
